

Dear customer:

Our company's legal team would like to inform you of the most important changes which **came into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008** with regard to the EU Regulation 561/2006:

**Since 1st January 2008:**

All drivers in charge of vehicles with analogue tachographs must be able to provide:

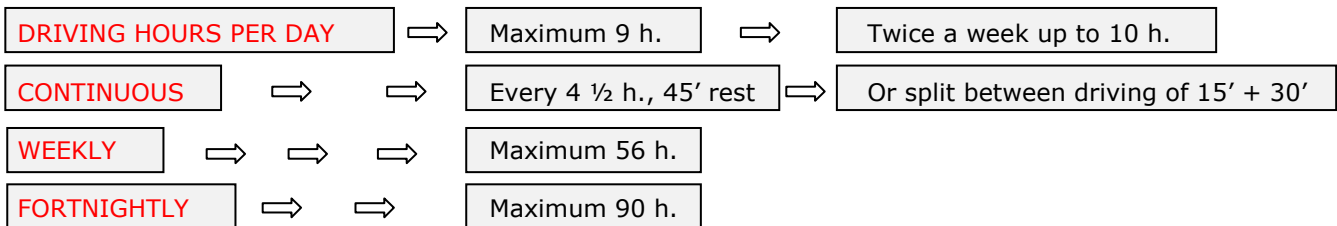
- The diagram disc for the day in question and **for the previous 28 days.**
- Driver's card (if in possession).
- All manual registers and copy for the previous **28 days (assuming journeys without card).**

All drivers in charge of vehicles with digital tachographs must be able to provide:

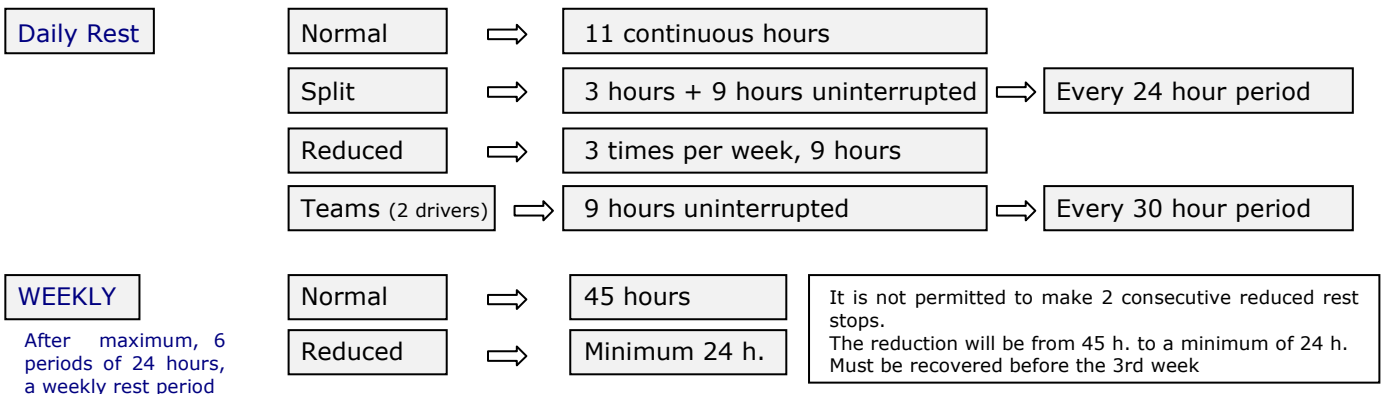
- Driver's card, so that the police can inspect the current day and **the previous 28 days.**
- The diagram disc for the day in question and **for the previous 28 days**, if they have driven vehicles with analogue tachographs in this period.
- All manual registers and copy **for the previous 28 days** (assuming journeys without card)

With regard to driving hours and rest periods, **they must not show variations.** The previous amendment was introduced on 11/04/2007. For a clear understanding we have included a summary chart.

**IMPORTANT:** Drivers are obliged **to use the activity selector on the tachograph** which corresponds to their current activity.
